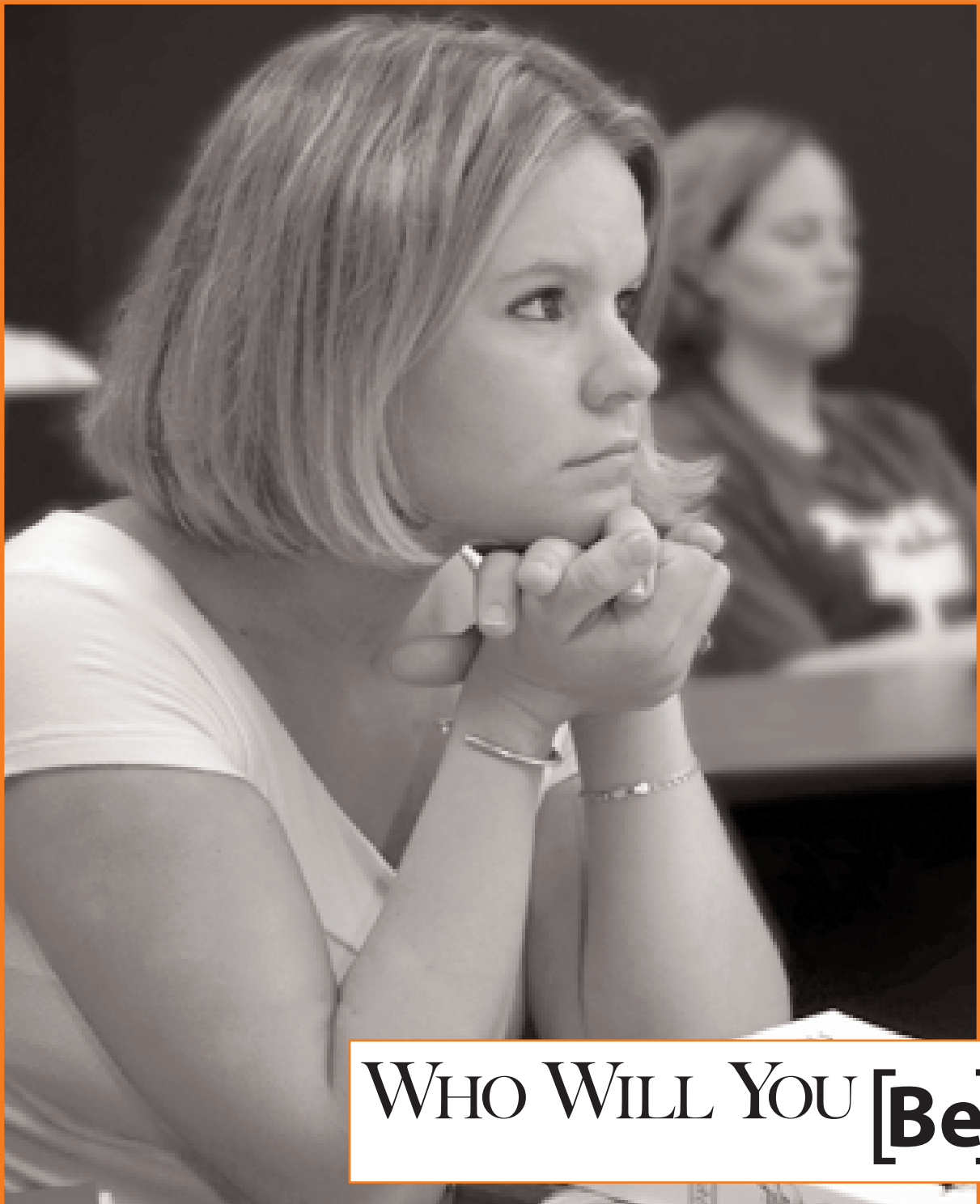

GENERAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Complete the Application for Admission after you've finished your junior year coursework. When you apply early, we can provide you with information on scholarships, services and special programs. You also may apply online at www.findlay.edu. NO APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED.
- Send an official high school transcript. Transcripts should include class rank, attendance information, a calculated grade point average (GPA) and proficiency tests results. Post-secondary option participants should submit transcripts of all college-level work.
- Give the enclosed teacher evaluation form to an instructor and have him or her return it to The University of Findlay's Office of Undergraduate Admissions.
- Submit the results of the American College Test (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT). You may send the results of these tests directly to Findlay by listing the following codes during test registration: ACT-3272, SAT-1223.
- In order to enroll, all candidates must submit their final transcripts after graduation.
- Admission decisions are made on a continual basis. Candidates will be notified of their admission status immediately.

ENROLLMENT PLANNING TIMELINE

Fall of Senior Year

- Apply for admission and pay enrollment deposit.
- Attend financial aid planning sessions.
- Plan your visit to campus.

Winter of Senior Year

- Apply for financial aid.
- Sign and return your award letter.
- Return housing, registration, orientation and other relevant forms.

APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID

- Send a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the Federal Processor OR, for faster service, file the FAFSA electronically at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Be sure to list The University of Findlay and its Title IV code #003045.
- In approximately four weeks, you will receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) in the mail. Review this document carefully. If everything is correct, keep the SAR for your records. If you find an error(s), correct the error(s) and send the SAR back to the processor.
- After you have been accepted for admission and we receive your financial aid information, the Office of Financial Aid will send you a financial aid award letter, which you should sign and return.
- We encourage you to apply for aid, regardless of your family's financial situation.
- Canadian students are not required to complete the FAFSA. However, Canadian students are required to submit an Affidavit of Financial Support before enrollment and meet requirements on attending college in the United States established by the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service.

VISITING CAMPUS

During your campus visit, you will discover a true picture of what we have to offer. You'll have the opportunity to meet with an admissions counselor, faculty and coaches; tour campus; and enjoy a complimentary meal in the dining hall. The Office of Undergraduate Admissions is open weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to noon. We ask that all students interested in the Equestrian and pre-veterinary medicine programs schedule their visits during mornings, Monday through Friday, to assure availability of staff and faculty.
