

Web Publishing – Connecting to the Server Using Mac OS X

Publishing to The University of Findlay’s Academic Web Server from Mac OS X requires a free software package called “Fugu”. Fugu is available for free download at the following Web site:

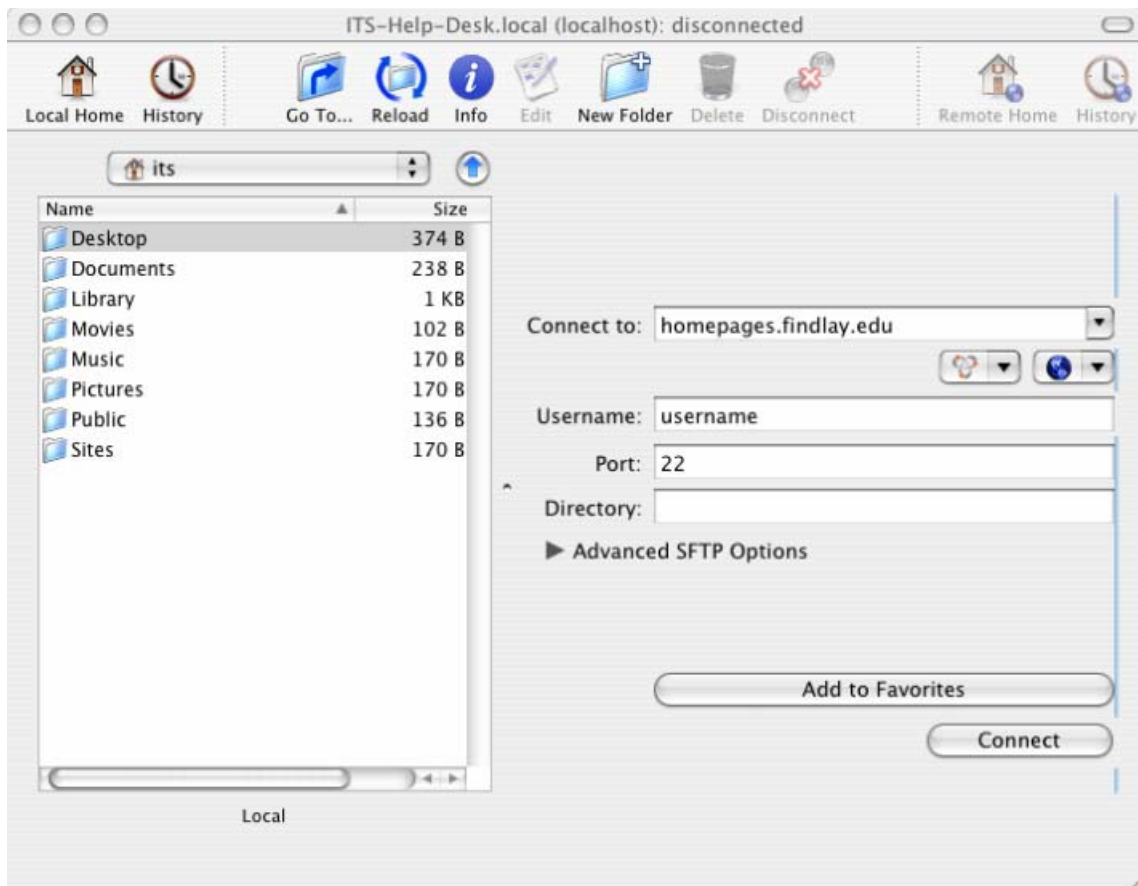
Once the software is downloaded and installed, it will create a “Fugu” icon in the Applications folder. To begin the connection process, double click the “Fugu” icon to launch the application.



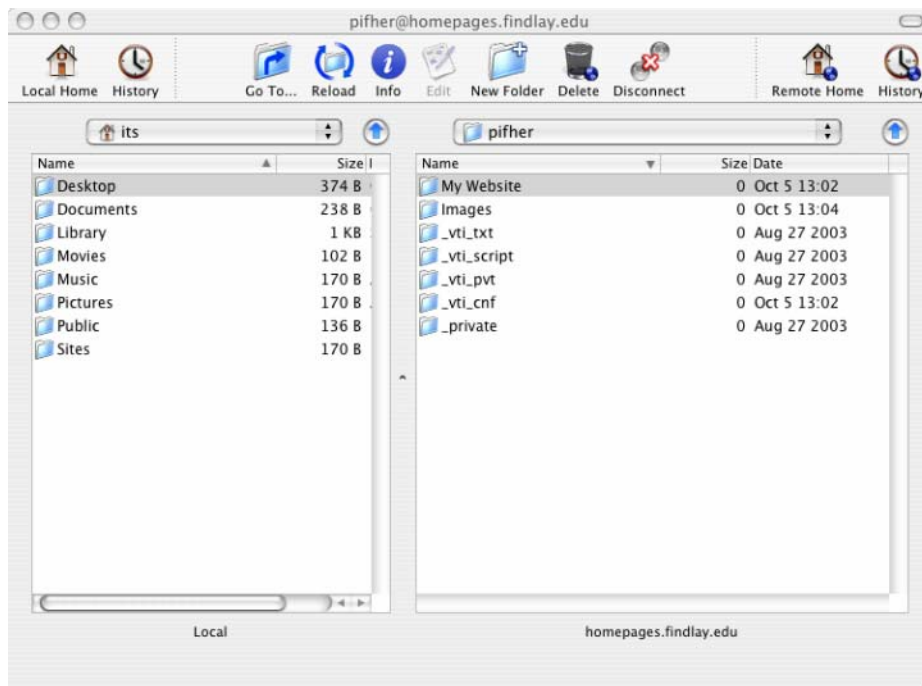
When Fugu opens, you will be presented with a connection screen like the one below. Fill in the following information in the specified fields:

Connect to: homepages.findlay.edu
Username: (Ufnet Account User name, i.e. username@findlay.edu)
Port: 22
Directory: Leave Empty

Once this information is filled in, your screen should look similar to the one below.



Next, click “Connect”. Fugu will then connect and prompt you for your UFnet account password. Type in your password and click “Authenticate”. Once authenticated, your screen will look like the one below. The pane on the left is your local machine and the pane on the right is your homepages directory. To publish your Web site, simply drag files or folders from the left pane to the right. When you are finished, be sure to disconnect.



Tips and Troubleshooting

If you are on a public Mac such as in a computer lab, please remember to not save your password and to disconnect when finished. This will prevent others from accessing your site.

You do not have to be signed on to UF's VPN (virtual private network) to access this service; however you do have to have a standard Internet connection. Please be sure your Mac is connected to the Internet before attempting to establish a connection.

All UFnet accounts have 20MB of space on the Academic Web Server. If you have trouble copying files, you may be over quota. Please contact the ITS Technology Support Services at Ext. 4357 if you feel that you need more quota for class purposes.
